



How 2+2 Works

- The 2+2 is a four- year program that allows students to earn a two- year associate degree from Blacksburg Community College (BHC) and Western Illinois University (WIU). This program is designed to ensure graduation in four years. The program is available for students who have completed the admission/audition requirements at BHC and have completed the four prerequisite required by BHC and WIU.
- Upon completion of the two- year program at BHC, student will receive an Associate of Art (A.A.) degree. Upon completion of the two- year program at WIU, student will receive the B.S. degree with a major in Criminal Justice Administration with a minor of the student's choice. Possible minors are listed in the catalog.
- A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00 should be achieved by the junior year and to graduate from BHC. This grade point average must be maintained for graduation from WIU.
- The BS in Law Enforcement Administration is available at the WIU Macomb and Quad-Cities Campus and online; the BS in Criminal Justice Administration is available at the BHC Quad-Cities or East Campus or online.
- Student following this program will complete a minimum of 120 total credit hours.
